Family time

Tug of war

An activity exploring the need for tension to make us strong.

You will need: a length, or lengths of rope; a piece of cloth or a scarf

- Have a length of rope long enough for two teams to hold at either end. The teams need be no more than one or two, depending on group size and space available.
- Hold a tug of war competition, or rounds, just for fun. Please note health and safety issues: make the teams as equal as possible; if mixed ages, talk to the older ones about sensible use of strength; and remember, the danger comes not from being pulled forward, but by falling back if the other team lets go!.
- Explain that the next challenge is more difficult. Tie a piece of cloth/a scarf to the middle of the rope and place a chair directly under it. The two teams have to work together to keep the cloth directly above the chair, but it must not drop down and touch it.
- Talk about how Jesus had the devil pulling at him, but he also had the Holy Spirit, and that gave him the balance and strength to stand firm.

Pray

Tug of war prayer

You will need: The rope/s from the Tug of war activity.

- Divide the group into two teams again and encourage each team to work together, to steady the cloth.
- Ask them to think about something they are struggling with at the moment a difficult decision or
 pressure to do the wrong thing. Imagine that they are pulling against it with the help of the Holy
 Spirit, and pray: Holy Spirit, give us your strength to make the right choices, go the right way and
 pull in the right direction. Help us to stay strong, and to help each other. Amen.
