

The Methodist Homestead Charitable Trust operates 24 Almshouse cottages in Northampton for those of retirement age. Our accommodation promotes independent and unassisted living and is set in own special and peaceful grounds.

The Trust is seeking to fill two vacancies as a result of forthcoming, planned retirements.

A Warden, responsible for ensuring the site runs smoothly and acting as the 'go to' person for routine matters relating to accommodation. The post is part-time, 24 hours a week and includes a license to occupy a first-floor 2 bedroom flat. (The Trust will consider applicants who live locally and wish to remain in their own home).

A Site Supervisor/Gardener, to maintain and manage the communal gardens and grounds and carry out core maintenance and gardening matters and should be knowledgeable about these areas and health and safety requirements. The post is part-time, 20 hours a week with some flexibility on hours depending on the season.

Ideally, applicants should hold a full driving licence. DBS checks will be carried out for both roles.
